Cross Country. Motion made by Bixler and seconded by Gray to create two races in Division III Boy's Cross Country at Miami Valley Career Technical Center (MVCTC). Race A will consist of twenty-three (23) schools and qualify four (4) teams and sixteen (16) individual runners while Race B will consist of eighteen (18) schools and qualify three (3) teams and twelve (12) individuals to Regional.
