Snow Emergency

In the event that a level 2 or 3 snow emergency is in effect in Goshen Township or Clermont County, all tournament matches will be cancelled and rescheduled for the day which the snow emergency is lifted.

In the event that a level 2 or 3 snow emergency is in effect in the county or city or township of a tournament participant, that participant's matches **will not** be postponed or rescheduled. Matches must take place if the tournament is being held. The tournament will be postponed if the **majority** of participant counties, cities or townships have snow emergencies.

School Cancellation

In the event that Goshen Local Schools cancels classes due to a weather emergency, but there is no snow emergency, there will be a decision made by noon of the day of the tournament if matches can be contested or not. That decision will be based on road and weather conditions, and input from principals and athletic directors. Goshen High School's policy is to play high school athletic contests if possible if school is cancelled.

If there is a decision to proceed with the tournament, and a participant school's policy is to not participate if school is cancelled, it is the hope of the Southwest District Board that school authorities will understand that there is a very small window of time available to conduct and finish the tournament and allow their wrestlers to participate in the tournament.

Alternate Tournament Dates

Alternate dates for the Division II Sectional tournament will be: Saturday, February 20; Sunday, February 21; and Monday, February 22 if needed.

Alternative dates for the Division II District Tournament will be: Sunday, February 28; Monday, March 1; and Tuesday, March 2.

- A. We will seed the top four wrestlers in each weight class based on the following criteria:
- State, District and Sectional place from 2008
 - Head to head competition vs other seed nominees
 - Record vs common opponents
 - Current overall record
- B. Brackets will be drawn during the meeting, but will not be official until after weigh-ins are official.

Friday, February 19, 2010

3:00 PM Sign in at the computer. Review records listed and make any corrections as needed. Please check all names, spelling and records on weigh-in sheet. Data will update automatically and transfer all the way to the State Tournament for those wrestlers who qualify.

4:00 PM Weigh-in. All wrestlers shall be present and remain in the designated weigh-in area.

- A. All *OHSAA Skin Authorizations* are to be appropriately signed and dated and must be presented at check-in.
- B. The weigh-in shall proceed through weight classes beginning at 103 lbs. and concluding with 275 lbs. A contestant may step on and off the first scale two times. If he fails to make weight on the first scale, he shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight.

5:30 PM Coaches Meeting. Please have wrestlers ready when called to the mat. Keep others in the stands or in the warm-up area. Only two coaches or a coach and a wrestler are permitted in the two chairs at the edge of the mat.

6:00 PM First Round (2,3,3.5,4)

Quarterfinals (5,6,6.5,7)

First Consolation (1,2,2.5,3) If 13 or more wrestlers in weight class

Second Day Weigh-ins will start when 140 lbs. quarterfinals begin and continue 20 minutes after the final match concludes.

10:00 AM Weigh-ins concluding at 10:30 AM

11:00 AM Second Consolation (1,2,2.5,3)

Semifinals (11,12,12.5,13) and **Third Consolation** (4,5,5.5,6)

Please note: Semifinals and Third Consolation will be wrestled simultaneously.

Consolation Semifinals (5,6,6.5,7)

5:00 PM First (4,4.5,5,6) Third (2,3,3.5,4) and Fifth (2,3,3.5,4) will be wrestled simultaneously. Presentations will be done after all wrestling is completed. Qualifiers will be asked to verify their name, year and record while waiting for the presentation.

Important

Please check with your qualifiers to confirm that the data listed on the qualifier form is correct. Athens (SE), Eaton, Tipp City, and Goshen each will qualify four (4) wrestlers per weight class. The fifth place wrestler will be the alternate. Please notify the District Manager (Mark Slagle) as soon as possible if you know that your qualifier will not be able to compete in the District Wrestling Tournament at Goshen. Four (4) wrestlers from the Goshen Division II District Tournament will qualify to the State Wrestling Tournament in Columbus.
