2012 WRESTLING TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS - Take what information is needed from these rules for your District Meets.

1. Managers are to seed the same number of qualifiers in each weight class and one alternate by vote of the coaches. Number to be seeded shall be the same in each weight class for the entire tournament. Wrestlebacks for the Sectional and District Meets (ALL DIVISIONS) will begin after the first round.
2. Once a wrestler is nominated by the coach for seeding, the wrestler then cannot be withdrawn from the seed by the coach. (Board Action)
3. Weigh-ins will be conducted at the tournament site prior to the first day competition in accordance with NF Rule 4-5-3. Weigh-ins for subsequent day(s) may be conducted during the evening preceding each subsequent day(s) competition. The tournament manager shall set weigh-ins within these limits.
4. An eligibility certificate, the minimum weight as listed on the Alpha-Master Roster and the wrestler weigh-in sheet must be provided to the tournament manager prior to starting the tournament.
5. Certification by Board motion: 1) A doctor or certified trainer must be present to check all athletes. 2) Tournament managers shall accept a state certified form signed by a physician relating to skin infection. 3) A registered wrestling official shall be employed to conduct weigh-ins. Board adopted April 12, 1997.
6. Officials fees: If an official works Friday night only, pay will be \$55.00. If an official works just Saturday of a two-day sectional tournament, pay will be \$190.00. If an official works the entire sectional tournament, pay will be \$245.00. Pay for officials working the entire district tournament will be \$315.00.
7. Admission for a one-day tournament will be \$12.00 for the first session and \$6.00 for the second session. All session pass will be \$15.00.

Admission for a two-day tournament will be \$6.00 per session (3 sessions). All session pass will be \$15.00.

Admission for a two-day district tournament will be \$12.00 for the first and second session (combined), \$6.00 for session three, and \$7.00 for session four (finals). All session pass will be \$22.00.
8. Each manager will be responsible for admittance of contestants, managers, cheerleaders and cheerleader advisors for all Sectional and District tournaments

Athletic Directors, Superintendents and Principals will use their yearly passes that have been mailed to them. Tournament managers will see that these passes should be used by school Administrators.
9. The only persons permitted in the wrestling area will be the wrestler and two (2) coaches. Violations will result in the removal of the coach from the wrestling area. A maximum of six (6) cheerleaders, in uniform and accompanied by an advisor, will be permitted to the Sectional/District Tournaments. They will be permitted only in the area designated by the Tournament Manager. (Board Action)
10. All weigh-ins shall be conducted by weight class (coaches recommendation 4-28-01).
11. All tournaments are to score all six places at the sectional level (coaches recommendation 4-28-01).
12. MANAGERS AND COACHES will adhere to the State regulations. Rules and regulations may be obtained from the OHSAA web site.

13. Division I Wrestling Tournaments will consist of two open draws—In the south one sectional at Lebanon and one at Hamilton. In the north, there will be two sectionals at Centerville. Per direction of the State Board of Control, all teams in a bracketed tournament will be seeded. The manager will distribute voting materials and procedures to each coach prior to the start of the Tournament Manager’s Meeting. This will enable each coach to vote and have his votes back to the tournament manager by Friday, Noon, January 27, 2012, before the Tournament Manager’s Meeting on Sunday, January 29, 2:00 p.m. The tournament manager will either distribute in written form or verbalize the team seed voting of all coaches in the tournament on the day of the Manager’s Meeting. All ties will be broken prior to the placement of teams on the bracket.
14. Qualifiers from Sectionals to District Tournaments:

Division I	Each sectional will qualify the top four (4) wrestlers in each weight class to the district tournament.
Division II	Top four (4) in each weight class from Eaton and Western Brown and top four (4) from Southeast sectionals will qualify for district. Top four (4) from Tipp City will qualify for Districts in Northwest.
Division III	Top four (4) qualifiers from Carlisle, Blanchester, and Lehman will qualify for district along with top four (4) from Northwest.

The District Wrestling Tournament will be held on Friday, February 24, 2012 and Saturday, February 25, 2012 at the following sites:

Division I	Fairfield H.S.
Division II	Goshen H.S.
Division III	Kettering Fairmont

15. Qualifiers to the State Meet will be four (4) in Division I, four (4) in Division II, and four (4) in Division III per weight class.
16. Team changes are as follows:
Sectional/District

All wrestlers who make weight and are eligible to wrestle

Each school will be allowed additional people based on number of competitors—one to six (1-6) competitors will receive four (4) additional passes, seven to ten (7-10) competitors will receive five (5) additional passes, and eleven to fourteen (11-14) will receive six (6) additional passes. These passes are for coaches, stats, managers, and support personnel.

Cheerleaders – A maximum of six (6) in uniform, along with an advisor.

17. All Sectional Managers are to send their results of their Tournaments to the District Tournament Manager by Sunday, February 19, 2012, at 10:00 a.m.
18. District Tournament Managers must submit a time schedule for their respective meet.
19. By District Board Action. A new Weather Cancellation Policy was adopted:

The Southwest District Board has established the following policy for cancellation or postponement of tournaments.

Schools participating in wrestling tournaments and reside in a county that experiences a Level Two (2) or Level Three (3) weather emergency, that SITE (tournament) will be postponed. Tournament managers must contact the District Board and make every effort to personally contact each schools coach, athletic director, or principal.

Schools are also encouraged to make use of the Board website (www.swdab.org) for updated information regarding postponements and cancellations.

The tournament manager will contact the Board Secretary, who will work with the managers to contact the "News Media".

Prior to the start of tournaments, the managers will be instructed to make available to the Board, a contingency plan for weather emergencies.
